

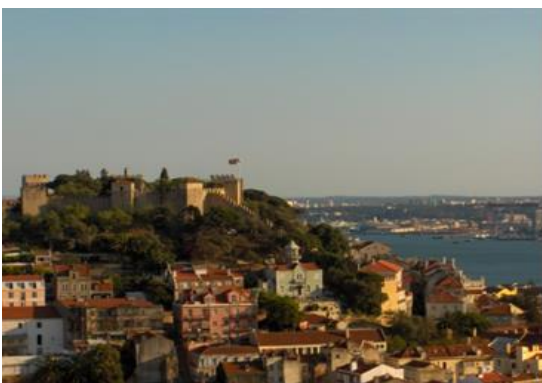

Insurance: Participants must be insured against illness, accident and third party damages.

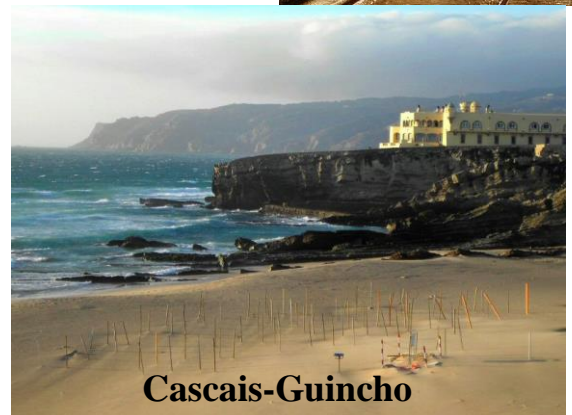
