The planning team is now busy making bookings and detailed planning for all events and experiences during the Camp.

In the following you will find details on the payment of the camp fee and some general information on travel arrangements.

CAMP FEE

As announced in the invitation, there is a camp fee.

Please transfer the **camp fee of Euro 700,00** to the beneficiary for the entire amount, <u>any banking</u> service costs will be borne by the sender.

For organizational reasons, the payment must be made within 15 days of registration for the camp and no later than May 15 2025.

Payment of the fee is our guarantee that we can economically engage in reservations etc. on your behalf.

The camp fee does not include flight tickets to arrival point and back, visa, personal insurance and pocket money.

TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

You will have to plan the travel to Italy by yourself.

Arrival

We ask that you arrive in the morning or early afternoon of June 21th. You will be met outside "Arrivals" at the airport by members of the camp team. From the airport clorser to Brescia, you will be transported to Brescia.

The closest airport to Brescia is **Milan Bergamo Airport (BGY)**, located 42.5 km away. Other nearby airports are **Verona (VRN)** (55.8 km) and **Milan Linate (LIN)** (73.4 km).

Departure

We expect you to depart from Airport closer to Brescia on the 04th of July. We will take care of transport from Brescia to the Airport.





ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

We expect to send you an email with detailed information on the program in the second half of May.

During the camp, numerous sports disciplines will be practiced: canyoning, climbing, trekking, mountain biking, windsurfing/sup. The intensity of the activities will be calibrated to the technical and physical level of the group, but good physical shape and ability to adapt to life in the open air and during camping are required

The accommodation will vary throughout the days of the camp, including a mix of **hotel**, **hostel**, **mountain lodge**, and **camping**.

MANDATORY MATERIAL

We recommend that you bring this equipment with you:

- rain jacket, short-sleeved technical t-shirt, long-sleeved technical t-shirt, sweatshirt or fleece sweater, wool hat, gloves, backpack document holder, sleeping bag, pillow, thermal water bottle.
- saline supplements, two pairs of walking or trekking shoes, pool slippers, swimsuit, large towel,
- headlamp for tented camps with new batteries, toilet material (toothbrush and toothpaste, soap, 2 towels, compostable toilet paper), sunglasses, sunscreen.

INSURANCE

Also, remember that you have to be insured against illness, accident, and third-party damages according to Rotary International recommendations. Ask your local Rotary District or Club for guidance.
